

First Transnational Meeting in Zaragoza (Spain)

From the 15th February to the 16th February 2023, the KA2 YESSS partners went to Zaragoza to meet each other face-to-face, and to work on the first project activities.

During those days, partners focused on the general objective of the project, the responsibilities and tasks of everyone. The coordinator, MDE40 Wipsee, presented the management tools used for the general organisation.

It was the opportunity to work on our national definitions about Social Economy, a concept really particular and specific. Our exchanges were rich and constructive highlighting different ways to define it. Actually, our discussions prove that there is the need to clarify and to popularise the concept of Social Economy in order to facilitate its accessibility to young people. For the SDGs, this is the same analysis. In fact, some European countries integrate the SDGs study in school as part of a compulsory study base. So, the level of knowledge about the SDGs and their aims is variable depending on whether you study SDGs since primary school, since university or neither one nor the other.

Partners went back to their country with the same aim : promote Social Economy and the SDGs for young people and youth workers.
