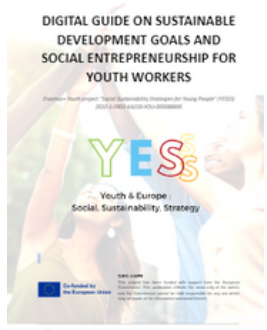


How do we begin working?

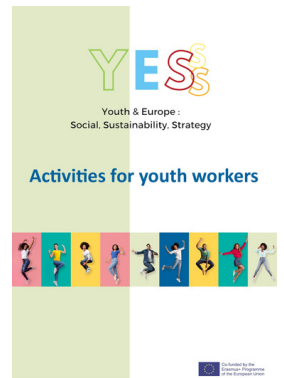


Digital guide on SDGs and Social entrepreneurs for youth workers

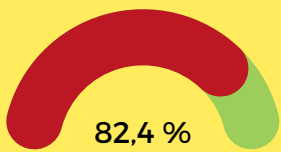

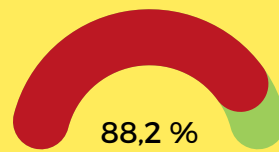
17 Europeans youth workers participated to the training on SSE and SDGs in April 2024

FN-forbundet is organizing a workshop for School Service to explore new ways of promoting UN initiatives and they will also participate in Verdenstimen, a platform for students and teachers to inspire projects aimed at achieving the SDGs. INNETICA and Gens XXII are partnering in the "New Generation of Roma Youth" project, empowering Roma communities through European tools and opportunities.
