

### Third Transnational Meeting in Pontonx-sur-l'Adour (France)

On 7 and 8 October 2024, the European partners in the YESSS project gathered for their very last face-to-face transnational meeting to take stock of everything that has been achieved in the last 2 years and to ensure the sustainability of the project and its results. Together, they were able to assess the impact of their project at local and European level:

- 1 support guide on the SDGs and the SSE for youth workers, translated into 7 languages.
- 17 youth workers trained during a transnational training course in April 2024, in France.
- 1 activity booklet with several activity sheets on the SDGs and SSE.
- 2 self-assessment tools on the SDGs and SE to encourage young people to become aware of the impact of their project and value their ideas.
- Over 300 people were reached by our local dissemination events.
- 1 website bringing together all the resources and tools created.
- + More than 10 videos of young Europeans sharing their experience of HE and the SDGs.
- More than 500 people were directly and indirectly impacted by the project over the last 2 years.

All the partners came away with a very positive assessment of the project and the partnership. Their final task is to finalise their sustainability plan and ensure that it is implemented as soon as the project ends. The partners have already talked about future projects and events at local and/or international level in which they will be using the project tools. They were also able to attend the dissemination event organised by the MDE40 WIPSEE in Dax (France) to meet and discuss with local players.
